



# Advise Your Child - As taught by AlQuran

## Surah 031-Luqman

Luqman, a wise person sat down with his child and gave him advice about certain things. Allah liked his advice and revealed it in the Quran so parents can give the same advice to their children.

*Allah Protects the Children of Righteous Parents*

**Verse 12 – Advise your child to be always thankful to Allah for everything He has given. Specially, knowledge, wisdom, education and understanding. Being thankful will benefit you.**

**12. And certainly, We had given Luqman wisdom, that give thanks to Allah. And whoever gives thanks, so indeed he gives thanks for (the good of) his ownself. And whoever is ungrateful, then indeed, Allah is Free of need, Owner of Praise.**

وَلَقَدْ آتَيْنَا لُقْمَانَ الْحِكْمَةَ أَنْ اشْكُرْ لِلَّهِ وَمَنْ يَشْكُرْ  
فَأَمْحَأْ يَشْكُرْ لِنَفْسِهِ وَمَنْ كَفَرَ فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ غَنِيٌّ حَمِيدٌ



**Verse 13: Luqman advised his son – Do not join anyone with Allah – He is One – Always ask Allah when you need anything, you are sick, or need any help.**

**13. And when Luqman said to his son, while he was advising him: “O my son, do not associate with Allah. Indeed, association is tremendous wrong.”**

وَإِذْ قَالَ لُقْمَانُ لِابْنِهِ وَهُوَ يَعِظُهُ يَا بُنَيَّ لَا تُشْرِكْ  
بِاللَّهِ إِنَّ الشِّرْكَ لَظُلْمٌ عَظِيمٌ

**Verse 14: Allah commands you to be always kind and good to your parents – Your mother suffered pains before you were born and she fed you for about two years. Then you were able to walk and eat with your hands. So always thank Allah that he gave you such good parents and always be kind and thankful to your parents.**

**14. And We have enjoined upon man about his parents. His mother carried him in weakness upon weakness, and his weaning is in two years, so give thanks to Me and to your parents. Unto Me is the journeying.**

**Verse 15: Do not join anyone with Allah and follow Allah’s way**

**15. And if they strive with you for that you associate with Me (as partners) that**

وَإِنْ جَاهَدَاكَ عَلَى أَنْ تُشْرِكَ بِيْ مَا لَيْسَ لَكَ بِهِ عِلْمٌ فَلَا

of which you have no knowledge, then do not obey them, and accompany them in the world kindly, and follow the way of him who turns in repentance to Me. Then to Me will be your return, then I shall tell you of what you used to do.

تَطْعُهُمَا وَصَاحِبُهُمَا فِي الدُّنْيَا مَعْرُوفًا ۖ وَاتَّبِعْ سَبِيلَ مَنْ

Verse 16: Allah knows everything even it is very small inside a rock-in the skies-in the earth

16. (Luqman said): “O my son, indeed, if it should be (equal to) the weight of a grain of mustard seed, then should be in a rock, or in the heavens, or in the earth, Allah will bring it forth. Indeed, Allah is Subtle, Aware.”

Verse 17: Pray your salat - tell others to do good - do not do bad things - be patient

17. “O my son, establish the prayer and enjoin kindness and forbid iniquity, and bear with patience upon whatever may befall you. Indeed, that is of firmness in (the conduct of) affairs.”

Verse 18: Do not show arrogance to other people – in your behavior or in your walk

18. “And do not turn your cheek in scorn toward people, nor walk in the land exultantly. Indeed, Allah does not love each self-conceited boaster.”

وَلَا تُصَعِّرْ خَدَّكَ لِلنَّاسِ وَلَا تَمْشِ فِي الْأَرْضِ مَرَحًا  
 إِنَّ اللَّهَ لَا يُحِبُّ كُلَّ مُخْتَالٍ فَخُورٍ

Verse 19: Show humbleness and kindness in your voice and in your walk

19. “And be moderate in your walking, and lower your voice. Indeed, the harshest of all sounds is the voice of the donkey.”

وَاقْصِدْ فِي مَشْيِكَ وَاعْضِرْ مِنْ صَوْتِكَ ۗ إِنَّ أَنْكَرَ  
 الْأَصْوَاتِ لَصَوْتُ الْحَمِيرِ

Surah Ibrahim14-Verse 40-41: Make Dua for your children and your parents

40. “O my Lord, make me to establish prayer, and from my offspring. O our Lord, and accept my supplication.”

41. “O our Lord, forgive me and my parents and the believers on the day when the reckoning will be established.”
